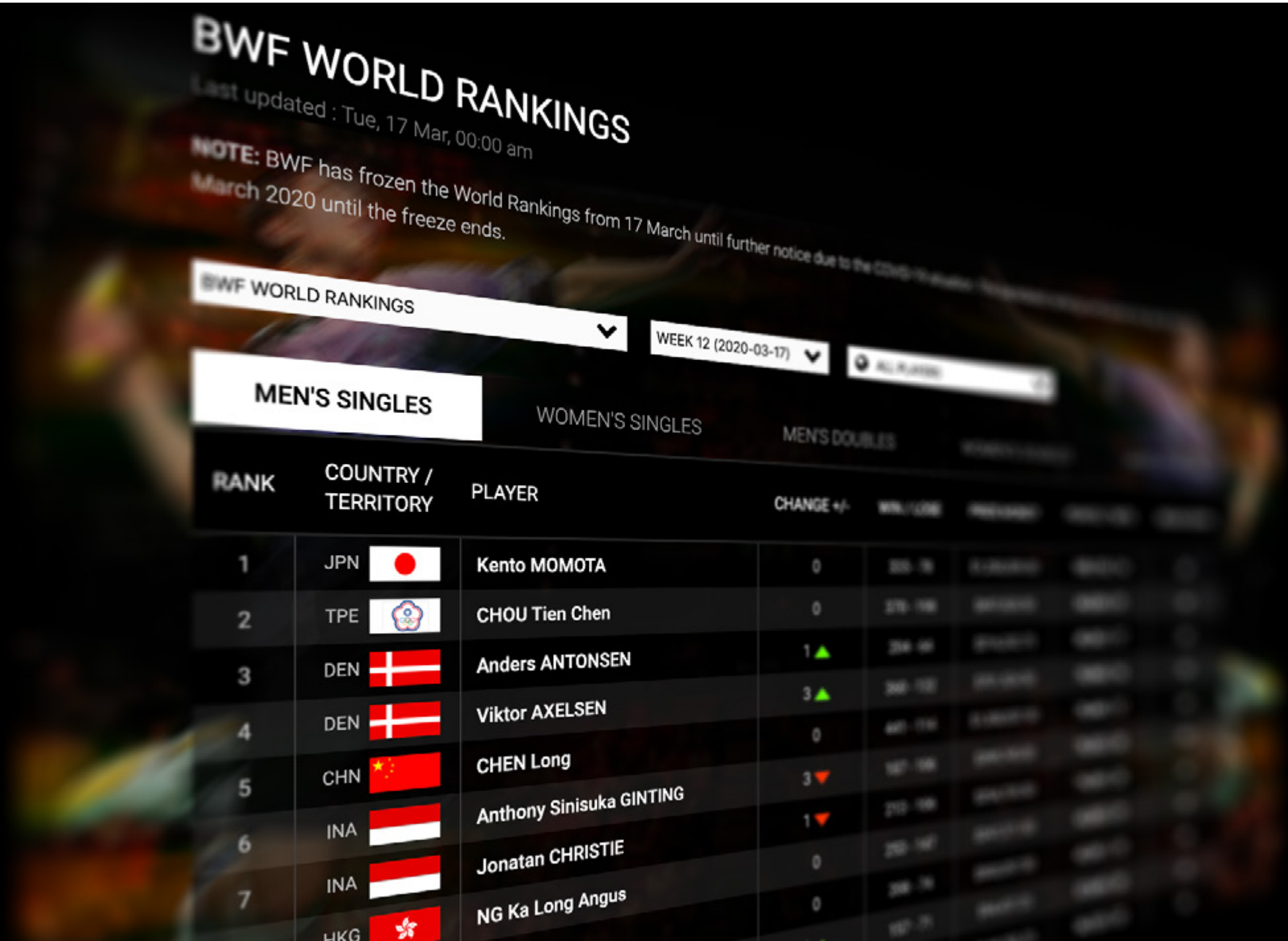
Outside the venue, you are encouraged to:

# Updates on World Rankings and HSBC BWF World Tour Finals

Please take note of this important information:

- ◀ World Ranking points will be awarded for tournaments played in 2020.
- ◀ Points will only be applied once the World Rankings are unfrozen.
- ◀ Draws and seedings will be based on the frozen World Rankings (17 March 2020).
- ◀ Players DO NOT have to participate in both the European and Asian legs to qualify for the HSBC BWF World Tour Finals 2020.
- ◀ Players must be entered for both Asia Open I 2020 and Asia Open II 2020 to qualify for the Finals.
